- Designed to encourage mass mobilization and inform citizen assemblies

## MASS DEATH ANALYSIS FRAMEWORK

ASIP's systematic study of climate mortality involves epidemiologists, demographers, and conflict experts creating rigorous frameworks for estimating climate-related deaths across scenarios.

Three-element approach: historical library of environmental mass death studies, systematic mortality analysis, and expert team evaluation of human and ecological consequences.

# Human Consequences of Climate Acceleration

- Increased mortality from extreme heat exposure across vulnerable populations
- Mass displacement from sea level rise affecting coastal communities globally
- Economic breakdown from agricultural system failures and crop losses
- Mass migration of billions from uninhabitable regions

- Compound disasters overwhelming emergency response capabilities
- Social conflict and resource wars intensifying with temperature increases
- Healthcare system collapse under climate-related disease burden
- Infrastructure failure cascading through interconnected systems

# The Misinformation Crisis

### Mainstream Science

Conservative, neutral tone

- Technical jargon and coded references
- Scientist-to-scientist communication
- Cautious uncertainty language
- Institutional risk aversion

### ASIP Method

Activist-oriented truth-telling

- Plain language emphasizing personal impact
- Public mobilization focus
- Precautionary risk framing
- Emotional engagement priority

# ASIP Implementation Strategy

- Educational talks presented in simple, jargon-free manner
- Written and online presentations using accurate, understandable language
- Explicit precautionary risk framing with clear metrics explanation
- Collaboration with '4 Billion Dead' campaign activists
