Through systematic destruction of life support systems that underpin human society

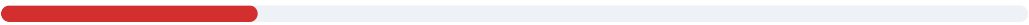
Cascading Societal Impacts

- Resource wars emerging from competition for basics

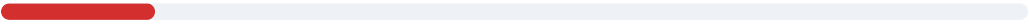
- Economic systems failing under environmental stress

Crisis Progression Indicators

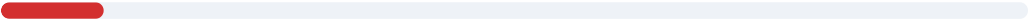
Water Crisis (Population Affected) **25%**



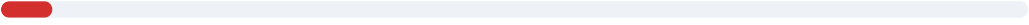
Food System Stability **15%**

PARADIGM SHIFT REQUIRED

Treat climate not as an 'issue,' but as the foundation of civilization

CONTEXT

This fundamental reframing is essential for appropriate policy responses

Policy Transformation Strategy

Current Approach

Extraction-Based Economy

- \$7 trillion in fossil fuel subsidies
- Climate treated as side issue
- Short-term profit prioritized
- Environmental costs externalized

Required Shift

Restoration-Based Economy

- Redirect subsidies to restoration
- Build renewable energy grids
- Massive reforestation programs
- Climate as civilization foundation

TIME-CRITICAL ACTION REQUIRED

The window for preventing civilizational collapse is rapidly closing. Immediate redirection of the \$7 trillion in annual fossil fuel subsidies toward restoration is essential.
